As you may already be aware, Pier Health Group along with Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire Clinical Commissioning Group, community services provider Sirona care & health and other key stakeholders have been working through a selection of shortlisted sites for a new healthcare centre for Graham Road patients. The new development at Weston Rugby Club was selected as our preferred option.

The Rugby Club site was chosen because it scored significantly higher than other site options overall, including on elements of accessibility criteria such as access to the building, disabled access and parking. In addition to parking, there is plenty of green space and room for new and additional services.

We are now having public consultation on the proposal to close Graham Road Surgery and relocate all of our patients to the new healthcare centre. Your views are important to us, and we hope you will take the opportunity to share them and help shape the new healthcare centre.

We are consulting with a wide range of interested people and organisations and of course our patients through public meetings, and the Patient Participation Group. As a patient we would value your opinion and this survey will help us with that.
